Every data subject has the right of access (Art. 15 GDPR), the right to rectification (Art.16 GDPR), the right to erasure (Art.17 GDPR), the right to restriction of processing (Art. 18 GDPR), the right to data portability (Art. 20 GDPR), as well as the right to object (Art. 21 DSGVO). The restrictions according to §§ 34 and 35 BDSG apply to the right of access and to the right to erasure. In addition, there is a right to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority (Art. 77 GDPR in conjunction with § 19 BDSG).

2. COLLECTION OF DATA AND INFORMATION

2.1 Data on your profile and web usage which is personally identifiable (personal data)

Personal data is information that relates to an identified or identifiable living natural person. This includes information such as your name, phone number or address.

> Why is my personal data collected?

Some pages of our website require personal information such as address, phone number or e-mail address. This data is used purely to post or e-mail you the required information and for the purpose of initiation and implementation of business relationships and customer support in general. It is your own free decision whether to enter this information and make use of the service.

> How long will my personal data be stored?

We store your personal data exclusively for the purpose for which you have disclosed it. By submitting your data you consent to the collection, the processing and the use of your data by IMACO as described above. You can revoke your agreement for collecting, processing and using your personal data at any time without stating reasons.

> Who gets my data? Is data transferred to a third country or to an international organisation?

IMACO will not pass on personal data to third parties unless explicitly indicated beforehand and agreed by you by means of a separate declaration. In exceptional circumstances we may be obliged to pass on personal data by the requirements of the GDPR for the data processing of certain contracts. Data is transmitted to analysis and marketing service providers within the framework of an order processing contract.

> What is this usage data needed for?

IMACO implements current technology in order to compile statistics on the usage of our web service. Web analytics tools collect and store anonymised data and create anonymised usage profiles from the collected data for the target-group-oriented design and optimisation of our web pages.

We use web analytics tools from the following providers:

Website analysis with Google Analytics

Google Analytics, a web analysis service provided by Google Inc., can be used to analyse which websites are visited more frequently or how the website structure is accepted by the users. Google Analytics uses cookies that enable the analysis of the web usage.

The information generated by the cookie about your use of the website will be transmitted to and stored by Google on servers in the United States. Your IP address will be shortened by Google within the Member States of the European Union or other states which are party to the Agreement on the European Economic Area. Only in exceptional cases will the full IP address be transmitted to a Google server in the United States and shortened there. On behalf of IMACO Google will use this information for the purpose of evaluating your use of the website, compiling reports on website activity and providing other services relating to website activity and internet usage at IMACO. Google may also transfer this information to third parties where required to do so by law, or where such third parties process the information on Google's behalf.

The IP address transmitted by your browser as part of Google Analytics will not be connected with any other data held by Google. You may refuse the storage of cookies by selecting the appropriate settings on your browser, however please note that if you do this you may not be able to use the full functionality of this website.
